Marie-Louise Schuttelaar, MD PhD, is an Associate Professor in the Dermatology Department of the University Medical Center Groningen in Groningen, The Netherlands. She is an academic dermatologist focused on providing high-quality patient care and innovative treatments and

conducting research. Her major interest is clinical and translational research in hand eczema, atopic dermatitis, and contact allergy.

Dr. Schuttelaar has been a principal investigator in several clinical trials and investigator-initiated studies on hand eczema and atopic dermatitis. She is a cofounder of the National Bioday Registry, which is focused on new systemic treatments for atopic dermatitis and comorbidities. She is a member of the steering group of the Hand Eczema Core Outcome Set (HECOS) initiative, the International Contact Dermatitis Research Group (ICDRG), and the board of directors of the European Surveillance System on Contact Allergies (ESSCA).
