Benjamin Ungar is an assistant professor in the Department of Dermatology at the Mount Sinai Hospital and became director of the Alopecia Center of Excellence at Mount Sinai in 2023. He is an IEC Councilor.

Dr. Ungar graduated from Harvard University cum laude in 2009 and began medical school at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai in 2011. From 2014 to 2016, he completed a research fellowship in the Laboratory for Investigative Dermatology at Rockefeller University, after which he graduated from medical school in 2017 with distinction in research.

After completing his intern year at NYU Winthrop Hospital, Dr. Ungar began his dermatology residency at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, from which he graduated as chief resident in June 2021. In the final year of his residency, he completed a T32 NIH Research Training Fellowship at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai.
